

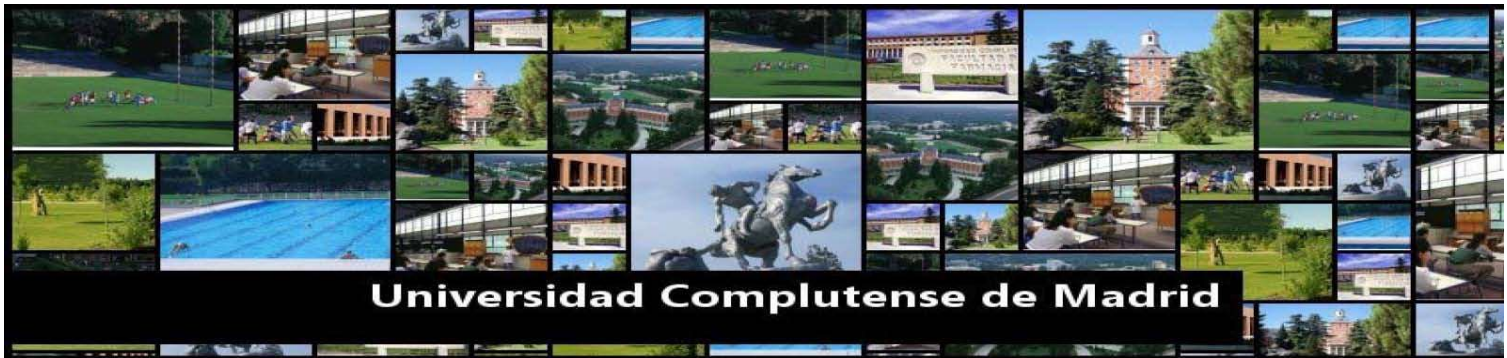

PROCEDURES FOR ERASMUS INCOMING STUDENTS

I. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

II. APPLICATION DEADLINES

| Semesters | From | To |
|-------------------------------------|------------|-------------|
| Full academic year (September-June) | 1 April | 30 May |
| First Semester (September-February) | 1 April | 30 May |
| Second semester (January to June) | 15 October | 30 November |

| For Philology (language) Students | From | To |
|-------------------------------------|------------|-------------|
| Full academic year (September-June) | 1 April | 15 May |
| First Semester (September-February) | 1 April | 15 May |
| Second semester (January-June) | 15 October | 15 November |



III. REQUIREMENTS

An adequate knowledge of the Spanish Language is required, given that classes at UCM are mainly taught in Spanish.

At least B1 Level is required (According to the European Common Framework of Languages)

Languages certificate is compulsory for Philology, Fine Arts, Commerce & Tourism, Media & Communication Science and Geography & History students

IV. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

All Erasmus students need to complete the UCM on-line **Application Form**. Please, click on the following link:

All sections should be completed.

You have the option to complete and save your application in multiple sessions. Once you have submitted the application online, any modification will be done by e-mail:

erasmus1@ucm.es

You must upload the following documents to your application:

- Photo (jpg,jpeg)
- Learning Agreement (signed and stamped by your home institution) (pdf)
- Transcript (pdf)

You can submit your application once all the sections on the menu are marked with green checkmarks. No more changes will be possible after submitting the application!

Only complete applications sent within the application period can be accepted.



V. ACCEPTANCE

After checking applications, UCM will send an **acceptance email** both to the student and the partner institution. Should you need a special acceptance letter or an invitation letter for your visa, please contact:

erasmus1@ucm.es

Two other situations are possible:

Refusal: If UCM cannot accept a student, both she/he and the partner institution will receive an email.

Cancellation: If a student withdraws from the programme, the partner institution will inform UCM as soon as possible

A double UCM acceptance is needed for students enrolled in doctoral studies, master's degree or dissertation:

1. **Academic acceptance:** Made by the Faculty, through the approval of the Learning agreement, previous to mobility.
2. **Administrative acceptance:** Made by the International Relations Office, through the present confirmation e-mail.
