My name is Alessandro Ispano and, since September 2016, I am an assistant professor at Université de Cergy-Pontoise. Before that, I obtained my PhD from Toulouse School of Economics (thesis defended in December 2014) and I did two years of postdoctoral studies at the Laboratoire d'Economie Industrielle of CREST (Centre de Recherche en Economie et Statistique). My main research interests are information economics and behavioral economics.

DESCRIPTION GÉNÉRALE DU COURS :

This is an introductory course to industrial organization, i.e. the branch of microeconomics that studies the strategic behavior of firms in imperfectly competitive markets, its impact on the choices of consumers and the effect of possible regulatory interventions. Typical topics we will cover are the determinants of offer and demand, monopoly, oligopoly, collusion, price discrimination...The approach will mainly be theoretical: to address these questions we will use (simple!) mathematical models. At the same time, we will stress the economic intuition behind each result and its practical implications. The course will be entirely in English.
